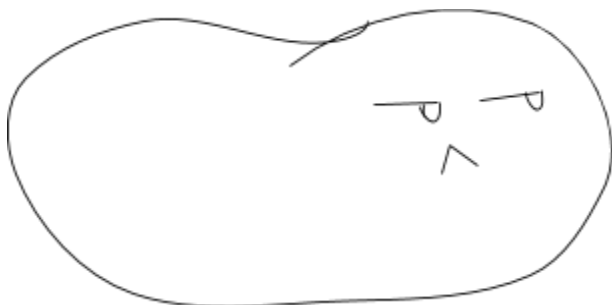
Movie: Cool Runnings
